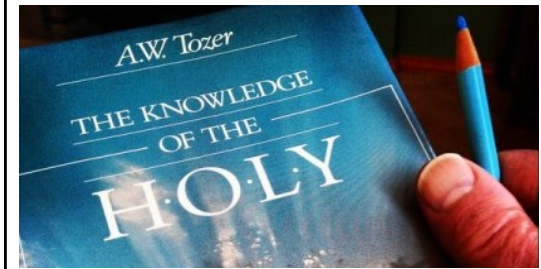

The Knowledge of the Holy

The low view of God entertained almost universally among Christians is the cause of a hundred lesser evils everywhere among us.

The decline of the knowledge of the holy has brought on our troubles. A rediscovery of the majesty of God will go a long way toward curing them.

What comes to our minds when we think of God is the most important thing about us.

The most revealing thing about the Church is her idea of God.

Low views of God destroy the gospel for all who hold them.

Perverved notions about God soon rot the religion in which they appear.

The essence of idolatry is the entertainment of thoughts about God that are unworthy of Him.

The heaviest obligation lying upon the Christian Church today is to purify and elevate her concept of God until it is once more worthy of Him— and of her.

Let's renew ourselves in the truth of who God is. Begin this season, investigating, studying, and contemplating the Word of God incarnate and behold His glory, "the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of GRACE and TRUTH" (John 1:14b).
