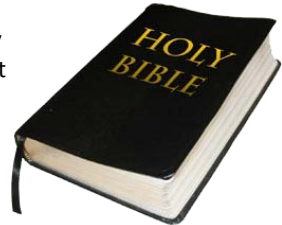

Family & Friendly Devotions

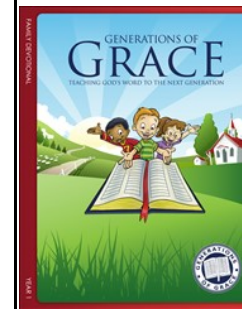
"Serve one another by love" (Gal. 5:13). What and how are you serving your family, your friends, or those closest to you?
