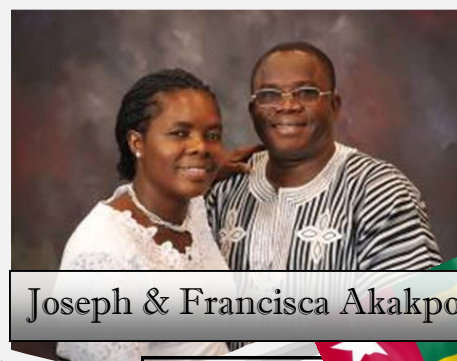

This summer, don't miss your chances to harvest spiritual fruit. I realize that many of us would claim to not have the gift of evangelism, but each of us *is* an "ambassador for Christ". Here's some thoughts on from Jews for Jesus that will challenge your thinking in this area of evangelism.

"Our love for God compels us to love others and to want them to be reconciled, first to God and then to one another. Yet reconciliation with God is a thoroughly supernatural event. It can only occur through the transformation of the new birth by the power of the Holy Spirit."

"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold all things have become new" (2 Cor. 5:17).

"Isn't it amazing that God wants to use ordinary people like you and me to help people find peace with God?"

"Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ and has given us the ministry of reconciliation" (2 Cor. 5:18).

"We know the miracle of being reconciled to God cost Jesus His very life. And here's the thing— it's bound to be costly for us to be committed to this 'word of reconciliation'."
