Here's an insightful excerpt from the recent update from our missionaries in Indo-Malaysia, who serve as Regional Directors with ABWE. Their names are intentionally unlisted here.

Sobering Missions Statistics*

Christian Missionaries per Religion:

Tribals – 1 missionary for every 60,000 Tribals

Unreligious – 1 missionary for every 71,000 Unreligious

Hindus – 1 missionary for every 179,000 Hindus

Buddhists – 1 for every 260,000 Buddhists

Muslims – only 1 missionary for every 405,500 Muslims

For every \$100,000 that Christians make, they give \$1 to the unreached. There are only 4,200 missionaries serving among the 1.7 Billion Muslims in the world!

Pray for them as they continue finish their responsibilities at ABWE headquarters. (Yes they have been there the same time as the Fifes- our recent ABWE appointees).
