Cool Bible Study Tools

Here's a sampling of my study in Titus.
Titus 2:11-14 For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people, training us to renounce ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in the present age, waiting for our blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, who gave himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness and to purify for himself a people for his own possession who are zealous for good works.

Observation

Grace is the key noun in this sentence.

Grace appears in the beginning (1:4), middle (2:11) and end (3:15) of the letter

Interpretation

There is a strong element of the:

Past- "the grace of God has appeared"

Present- "teaching us... in this present age..."

Future- "waiting for our blessed hope, the appearing..."

This coincides with the gracious work of God in salvation, sanctification and glorification.

Application

Paul emphasizes in one centrally placed sentence that God's **GRACE** interrupts with power and authority. God impacts the believer and saves him and transforms him.

We are to **put-off** of sin ("renounce ungodliness and worldly passions") and **put-on** the new man ("live self-controlled, upright and godly lives").

We are to look to a glorious future with Christ with the **gracious** effect that we ("a people for his own possession") are passionate for doing good works. These are the marks of "God's elect" (1:1) who "adorn the doctrine of God our Savior" (2:10) and are dedicated to "good works" (2:14 & 3:14). People then see us full of GRACE...

Do people see you as a person immersed in the Grace of God? Take time this week to immerse yourself in the "grace of God".
