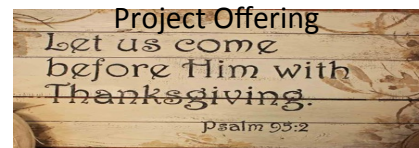

VETERANS DAY

HONOR THOSE WHO SERVED

November 11, 2016

Established at the end of World War I, on November 11, 1918, Armistice Day later became known as Veterans Day— A celebration to honor America's veterans for their patriotism, love of country, and willingness to serve and sacrifice for the common good.

Veterans Day, not to be confused with Memorial Day, honors the more than 22 million who have served our country in the Armed Forces and have re-entered back into our society. "In fact Veterans Day is largely intended to thank living Veterans for their service, to acknowledge that their contributions to our national security are appreciated, and to underscore the fact that all those who served— not only those who died— have sacrificed and done their duty." Thank a veteran this week and the next and the next. Also, take time to give THANKS to God, who has blessed us with the current freedoms that we now enjoy in the United States of America.

Then consider the believing veterans that have now returned to "civilian" life. Their lives are completely different and the battle front is almost unseen as revealed in Ephesians 6:12

"For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms."

There are lessons here for you and I to learn. Evaluate your own life in light of this verse. Are you ready for the battle that "*wages war against your soul*"? Have you heeded the command that we are to "*demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.*" (2 Corinthians 10:5)

Remember that there are no civilians in the Lord's army. As we serve the LORD shoulder to shoulder, let's "be strong", "put on the whole armor", "stand", "pray", and "keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints" (from Ephesians 6). And this week, we may start marching on our knees. And may all who come behind us find us faithful.
