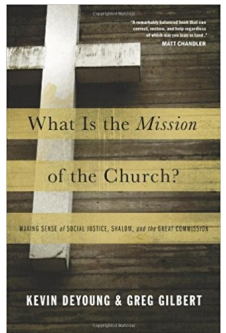
Our primary activity is evangelizing, equipping and encouraging of one another, that all might be conformed to His Word and transformed into Christ-likeness (Ephesians 4:13)
