**Excerpts from Good Journals**

*How Does Sanctification Work? (Part 1)*

By David Powlison



"Sanctification is discipleship into His way of life. What is his way of life? Jesus is the man of faith who lives within the psalms, depending on mercies. He is the man of wisdom who lives out proverbs, fearing the Lord. He is the man of righteousness who simply loves God and neighbors. He is the man of redeeming mercies who embodies Exodus 34:6-7 and Numbers 6:24-26. He is the servant of the Lord who lays down his life for others."

"Conversion is the first step in a long salvation, initially from sin's penalty, gradually from sin's power, and ultimately from sin's presence."

"It is easy to extrapolate your own experience into a general rule: 'This must be the key for everyone.' Both Scripture and personal testimony teach us that there is no single formula for the kinds of problems that call for sanctification. There is no single formula for the kinds of change that sanctification produces. There is no single formula for the truths and other factors that produce change."

"Ministry 'unbalances' truth for the sake of relevance; theology 'rebalances' truth for the sake of comprehensiveness."

"There is no formula or pat answer."  
"Learning how God is essentially *for* you and *with* you is foundational for every Christian. And there are so many different ways he shows it!"  
"It is not surprising that God's way of working idiosyncratically, not formulaically, touches the most intimate, vulnerable acts of relationship with him."

"Wise ministry, like growth in wisdom, means learning to play on all the strings, not harping on one note."

"We needed sanctifying this morning- as we do every morning."
