## Introduction:


Superscription: "For the choir director; on the Gittith. A Psalm of Asaph."

## I. A CALL TO REJOICE IN THE PRESENT (vs. 1-5)

A. By Song (vs. 1-3)

"Sing for joy to God our strength; shout joyfully to the God of Jacob."

"Raise a song, strike the timbrel, the sweet sounding lyre with the harp."



APPLICATION #1:

"Blow the trumpet at the new moon, at the full moon, on our feast day."

B. By Statute (vs. 4)

## II. A CALL TO REMEMBER THE PAST (vs. 6-12)

A. Your Ingratitude (vs. 6-8)

"I relieved his shoulder of the burden, his hands were freed from the basket."

"I proved you at the waters of Meribah. Selah." (Jn. 7:37-38; Ps. 95:7-11)	
"Hear, O My people, and I will admonish you; O Israel, if you would listen to Me!" (Deut. 6:	4; 5:29)
APPLICATION #3:	
B. Your Idolatry (vs. 9-10)	
"Let there be no strange god among you; nor shall you worship any foreign god." (Ex. 20:3	-5; Deut. 5:6; 32:16)
"Open your mouth wide and I will fill it."	
APPLICATION #4:	
C. Your Independence (vs. 11-12)	
"But My people did not listen to My voice, and Israel did not obey Me."	
"So I gave them over to the stubbornness of their heart, to walk in their own devices."	
APPLICATION #5:	
A CALL TO REPENT BEFORE THE FUTURE (vs. 13-16)	
A. Or You'll be Left to Your Follies (vs. 13)	
"Oh that My people would listen to Me, that Israel would walk in My ways!" (Deut. 31:9-13)	
B. Or You'll be Left to Your Foes (vs. 14-15)	
"I would quickly subdue their enemies and turn My hand against their adversaries."	
"Those who hate the LORD would pretend obedience to Him, and their time of punishment v forever."	vould be
C. Or You'll be Left to Famine (vs. 16)	
"But I would feed you with the finest of the wheat, and with honey from the rock I would sati (Deut. 32:13-14)	sfy you."
